LEARNING OUTCOMES

The general aim of this course is to familiarize students with the practice of proofreading and editing texts, aiming to serve as a foundation for a potential professional career, as well as for correctly presenting their own texts when submitting them to repositories or for publication. As far as Editing is concerned, students become acquainted with the issues in publishing a text and learn to provide solutions to specific texts under publication, such as, for example, narratives by Xenopoulos or 'Number 31328' by Venezis as published in the newspaper 'Kampana'.

In detail, upon completion of this course, students should be able to:

- Identify spelling, typographical, and other errors.
- Correcting texts as far as accuracy is concerned.
- Possess bibliographic knowledge regarding publishing matters.
- Be able to publish a text and write an editorial note.
- Form a book, including title, cover, contents, author's notes and back cover.
- Be able to analyze literary texts.
