More specifically, upon completing the course, students should be able to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Understand and use the methodological concept of “generation” in Modern Greek poetry; - Know some of the most important Greek poets of the generation of the 1970’s; - Recognize and analyse the thematics, the style and the versification of poets of the 1970’s; - Connect the poetry of this generation with the social conditions and the ideological context of the period after the fall of the military junta 1967-1974; - Use the relevant bibliography; - Write a scientific essay.
