- 4. The years after the Fall of Constantinople (16th-17th): The venetian rule, Turkish occupied areas. New cultural centers (Venice, Crete, Cyprus). The Renaissance, the Petrarchismus. Text Study
- 5. Greek Enlightenment. To glossiko zitima. 18th. Phanariots, Paradounavies Principalities. Koraes
- 6. 19th: the pre-revolutionary poetry. Solomos, Kalvos, A. Valaoritis.
- 7. In the years of Romanticism: Poetry and prose.
- 8. "The generation of 1880": "New Athenian School". The ethography. To glossiko zitima again. Palamas.
- 9. The turn of the century: Ways of realism in prose. Aestheticism, Socialism, Symbolism. Poetry after Palamas. A. Sikelianos, C. P. Cavafy, K. Kariotakis).
- 10. Interwar period. Left and literature. Modernism. The Generation of the '30s.
- 11. Postwar literature. Poetry and prose.
