Information concerning entries and abbreviations used in the lists

All the dates are A.D., unless otherwise stated. **Kyno** stands for the capital of the KN. **KN** stands for the "Cynopolite nome". **Phe** stands for Pheretnouis

The list of the **PAPYRI REALATED TO THE UPPER CYNOPOLITE NOME** is based on the evidence provided by the name "Cynopolite nome", the ethnic of the persons "Cynopolite", the adjective "Cynopolite", and the references to villages of the Upper Kynopolite nome.

In the entries of the **PROSOPOGRAPHY OF THE KYNOPOLITE NOME** only the persons who are attested to be for various reasons in the KN are listed. However, the name of people who were used for their identification (patronym etc.) are not listed. Reference to a *strategos* of the Cynopolite nome without mentioning his name is in *P.Oxy*. LV 3781 (A.D. 117), who is different than the *strategos* of the Oxyrhynchite nome.

In *P.L.Bat.* XI 26 (III-IV A.D.; cf. *BL* 5, p. 65) there is a reference to the *strategos* ėv Kuvũ<v> (Hierakammon?).

royal scribes:

Reference to a royal scribe for the nomes Oxyrhynchite and Cynopolite is made in P.Oxy. IX 1210 (late I B.C. - early I A.D.) (cf. BL 3, p. 135).

An official ὁ ἐπὶ τῶν ἰερῶν is attested in *P.Oxy.* XII 1453,14 (30-29 B.C.); cf. *P.Oxy.* XII 1449, introd.
