<p>The main purpose of this lesson is learning of syntactic and grammatical structures. Since the Turkish language contains elements unusual for the Greek student, such as its adhesive structure and vowel harmony, emphasis is given on the complete knowledge of the grammar of the language.</p> <p>Upon completion of the course (four semesters), students have the necessary skills to meet the communication needs both in written and spoken language.</p> <p>The students participating actively in the course will learn:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Vowel and consonant harmony • Endings, suffixes • Cases (Locative, Ablative, Accusative, Dative, Genitive) • Nouns • Pronouns
